Visually minimal, Scoop is simple, compact and clever. Clever in that each item stacks. Simple construction; tubular steel frames and pressed ply seats with their own unique character give Scoop a freshness over and above the plethora of existing mono shell designs on the market.

Finishes

Seats are veneered with a rich 'Alpi Lignum' design, similar to Zebrano veneer, which can be stained to achieve alternative shades. Scoop is also available in beech veneer, which can be clear lacquered, or stained and lacquered.

Fraser Lee graduated from the Royal College of Art in 1984, exhibiting at numerous shows; he won a number of design awards, including a travel scholarship.
